

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR THE OPENING OF A SELECTION OF A RESEARCH GRANT- (BI) 1 VACANCY

Reference 2025_069_BI_BIOPORTS

A competition is open for the attribution of 1 research Grant in the framework of the project BIOPORTS - Combining biotechnology and robotics to prevent and eliminate pollution inside ports, with the reference COMPETE2030-FEDER-00894400, supported by Compete 2030, according to the following conditions:

1. Scientific area: Biotechnology, Biology or similar areas

2. Admission requirements

- i) The candidates must hold a degree in Biology or similar area (with classification equal or higher than 15 values (in 20)) and a Master degree in Biotechnology or similar area (with classification equal or higher than 18 values (in 20));
- ii) Be enrolled in a doctoral programme in Environmental Sciences and Technology;
- iii) Experience in bioremediation;
- iv) Experience in marine microbiology;
- v) Experience in bioinformatics tools for analysis of prokaryotes;
- vi) Experience in working in research projects.

In the event the degree was awarded by a foreign higher education institution, said degree must comply with the provisions of Decree-Law no. 66/2018 of 16th August until the signature of the contract.

3. Work plan:

The selected candidate will work for the project BIOPORTS, namely within the task 1 - Definition of operational conditions for bioremediation inside ports; task 2 - Microbial consortia for bioremediation of oils and HNS; and task 3 - Optimization of microbial biomass production.





4. Legislation and official rules:

Law nº.40/2004, 18th August (Research Fellowship Holder Statute) in its current version; Regulations for Studentships and Fellowships of the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P. and CIIMAR Grants Regulation.

5. Work place:

The work will be carried out at CIIMAR, Edifício do Terminal de Cruzeiros do Porto de Leixões, Av. General Norton de Matos, s/n, 4450-208 Matosinhos, under the supervision of Dr. Ana Paula Mucha.

6. Duration of the contract:

Duration of 12 months, starting in September 2025, under the regime of exclusive dedication.

7. Monthly salary:

The monthly maintenance allowance is 1309,64 €, in agreement with the monthly maintenance stipend table of the grants directly attributed by FCT, I.P. within the country https://www.fct.pt/wp-content/uploads/2025/02/Tabela valores SMM 2025.pdf, by bank transfer payment.

8. Selection methods:

The first ranking of candidates will be performed after a CV evaluation based on:

- Academic grades plus scientific area: 50%;
- Experience in the research field: 50%.

If necessary, an interview will be done to the three top candidates, after which a final ranking will be performed based on:

CV evaluation: 80%;

• Interview: 20%.





The jury reserves the right to not assign the research grant if none of the candidates meets all requirements and match the desired profile.

9. Composition of the jury selection:

10. Form of advertising/notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be sent through a list sorting the candidates according to their attributed mark, by e-mail and available in CIIMAR website; in case of disagreement, the candidates have a 10-working day term in which to contest the decision, if he/she so wishes, as provided for in the Código do Procedimento Administrativo in a preliminary hearing setting. The jury reserves the right to not assign the contract depending on the quality of the applications.

11. Deadline for application and presentation of applications:

The competition is open from **August 08th to August 22th 2025**. The applications must state the reference in the subject "2025_069_BI_BIOPORTS" and cannot exceed 20 MB and must be formalized, compulsorily, by sending the following documents:

- Detailed Curriculum vitae;
- Copy of the eligibility certificates;
- Evidence of enrolment in a doctoral program;
- Motivation letter;
- Contact e-mail address and phone number.

Applications must be sent by email to rh@ciimar.up.pt. Applications that **do not include all** the elements previously indicated will **not be considered**.





12. Non-discrimination and equal access policy:
